Webinar Report: “Pharmacovigilance: Need of the Hour”

Overview: The webinar titled “**Pharmacovigilance: Need of the Hour**” was conducted by Dr. Saurabh Kosey, an expert in the field of pharmacy practice. The session provided valuable insights into the importance of Pharmacovigilance in modern healthcare, focusing on its role in ensuring drug safety, minimizing adverse effects, and protecting public health.

Key Highlights:

1. **Introduction to Pharmacovigilance:** Dr. Kosey began by introducing the concept of Pharmacovigilance, which involves the detection, assessment, understanding, and prevention of adverse effects related to Pharmaceutical products. He emphasized that Pharmacovigilance is essential to improving patient safety and ensuring the efficacy of drugs on the market.

He stressed the importance of their involvement in ADR reporting, data collection, and promoting patient awareness about drug safety.
4. **Challenges and Global Trends:** The speaker also touched upon the challenges faced in Pharmacovigilance, such as underreporting of ADRs, lack of awareness, and the need for better regulatory frameworks. He highlighted emerging trends like the integration of technology and data analytics in enhancing the efficiency of Pharmacovigilance practices worldwide.
5. **Future of Pharmacovigilance:** The session concluded with a discussion on the future of Pharmacovigilance, including the role of artificial intelligence, machine learning, and big data in predicting and preventing adverse drug reactions. Dr. Kosey encouraged participants to stay updated with the latest trends and advancements in the field to contribute effectively to patient safety.

Conclusion: The webinar provided a comprehensive overview of Pharmacovigilance and its growing importance in the healthcare sector. Dr. Kosey’s expert insights helped participants understand the critical need for proactive drug safety measures and the essential role pharmacy professionals play in this field. 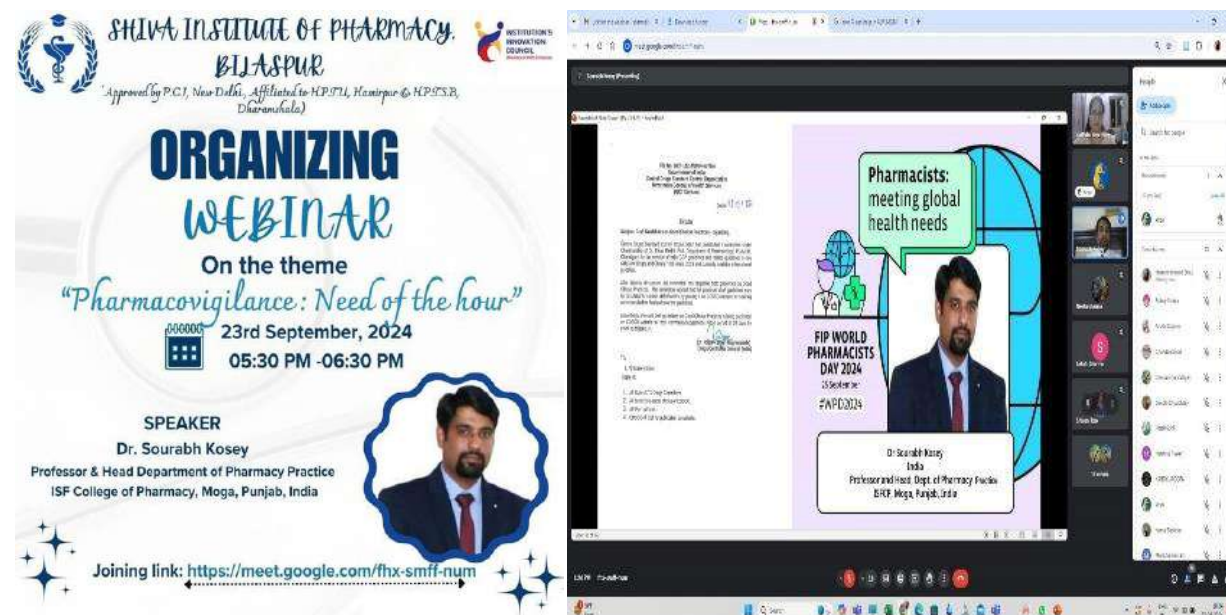


Figure 10: Webinar on “Pharmacovigilance: Need of the Hour” by Dr. Sourabh Kosey @ Shiva Institute

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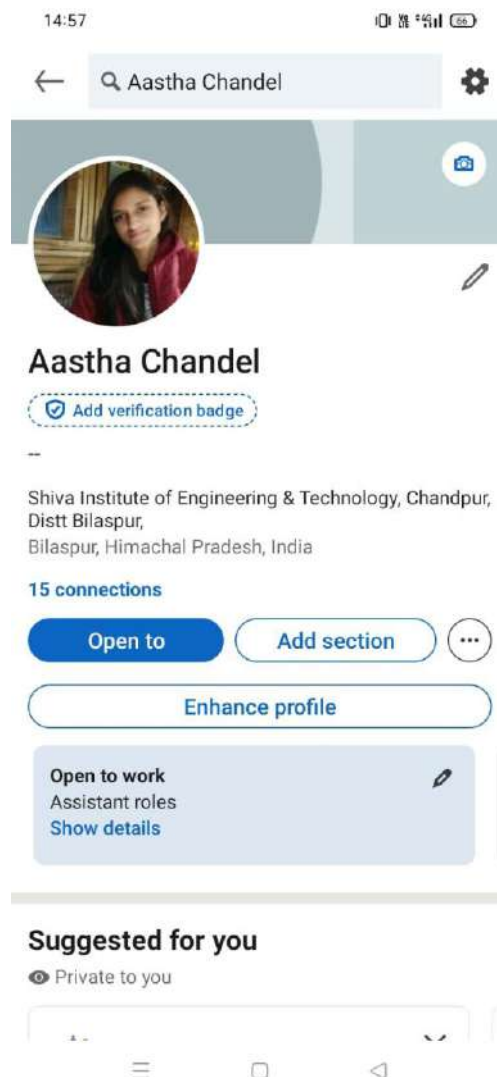

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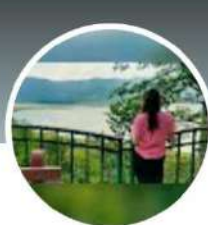

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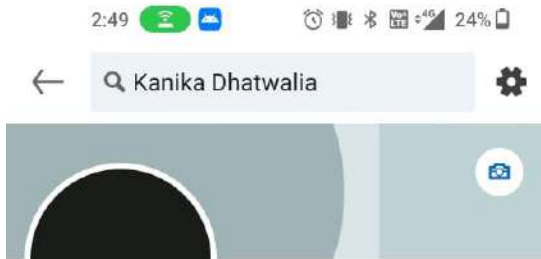
